## What Vein Treatments Are Available?

The best vein specialist may use different vein treatments based on your diagnosis. Your doctor has expertise in use of a wide range of procedures to treat vein or artery disease, including:

- <u>Endovenous laser ablation</u>. This minimally invasive procedure treats damaged veins through heat generated by laser technology. The heat damages the vein walls to eliminate the defective veins.
- <u>Endovenous radiofrequency ablation</u>. An advanced minimally invasive technique, RFA treats venous insufficiency through use of radiofrequency waves to cauterize and close the malfunctioning varicose veins.
- <u>Endovascular therapy</u>. This minimally invasive procedure is done inside affected blood vessels to unblock an obstruction or remove a clot. A top vein doctor uses a variety of transcatheter techniques, including a <u>balloon angioplasty</u> or <u>permanent mesh stenting</u>.
- <u>Sclerotherapy for spider veins</u> and <u>varicose veins</u>. Sclerotherapy is a procedure for treating defective or dysfunctional A vein specialist injects a solution directly into an affected vein, which causes the vein to scar, close and die. The blood that flowed through the vein reroutes through nearby healthy veins.
- <u>Ambulatory phlebotomy</u>. This is a surgical procedure to remove damaged superficial veins, such as varicose veins, through tiny incisions made in the skin.
- <u>Thrombectomy</u>. This surgical procedure is used to remove a blood clot inside an affected artery or vein.
- <u>Vascular and arterial embolization</u>. Embolization involves cutting off the blood flow to a specific blood vessel. A doctor injects embolic agents into the affected artery or vein to prevent further blood flow.
